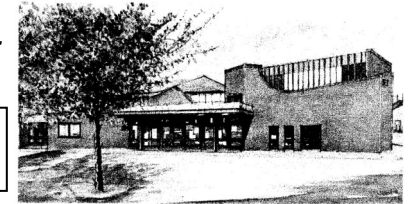

## Dave Bilbrough LIVE - Saturday 22nd September

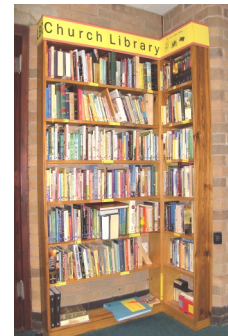
